Tough Questions for Donald Trump from America's Families

*Texas Values Action and its national family policy alliance
say questions remain for Donald Trump*

Austin, TX – Texas Values Action, and its national alliance of nearly 40 state-based family policy councils representing millions of Evangelicals nationwide, today released an [open letter](#) to presidential candidate Donald Trump calling on him to answer direct questions on his policy positions.

Jonathan Saenz, President of Texas Values Action, said, “It is past time for Mr. Trump to clear up his contradictory record on critical issues that Texans, and millions of Americans across the country, care about. Pro-family voters care deeply about protecting religious freedom, restoring marriage between one man and one woman, and defending the unborn. Mr. Trump’s public comments and record on these fundamental issues are particularly concerning to Texas voters and should be to all Americans.”

Leading candidates have been invited to participate in CitizenLink’s Presidential Candidate Teleconferences. So far, Sens. Ted Cruz and Marco Rubio, and former Gov. Jeb Bush have participated on the calls, as well as former Sen. Rick Santorum and former Hewlett-Packard CEO Carly Fiorina, prior to suspending their campaigns. Dr. Ben Carson is scheduled for later this month. Donald Trump has been invited several times to join the Presidential Candidate Teleconference Series but has yet to accept.

“With the recent passing of conservative Supreme Court Justice Antonin Scalia, the issues of marriage, life, religious liberty and the proper role of the Judiciary require even more focus,” Saenz explained. “Mr. Trump’s public comments about nominating judges with the same temperament as his sister, Maryanne Trump Barry, who overturned the New Jersey Partial-Birth Abortion Ban, are deeply troubling to Christians and pro-life Americans across the country.”
